Reading: Psalm 85 NIV

For the director of music. Of the Sons of Korah. A psalm. You, LORD, showed favor to your land; you restored the fortunes of Jacob. ² You forgave the iniquity of your people and covered all their sins. ³ You set aside all your wrath and turned from your fierce anger. ⁴ Restore us again, God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us. ⁵ Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations?
